- All students will remain in their exam for one (1) hour.
- Students will report to school for scheduled examinations only. Attendance will be taken in the examination room.
- Wednesday, June 18th, and Thursday, June 19th, are both regular school days with adjusted period 1
 assembly schedules to accommodate exams. As such, students are expected to report to school in full and
 complete uniform on these days.
- Students may come to write their exams out of uniform on Friday, June 20th, and Monday, June 23rd. Students should be dressed appropriately to write their exams.
- Students who are late to their exam are to report to attendance to see Mr. Welsh or Mrs. Mastroianni.
- Missing a scheduled exam without a medical certificate will result in a zero (0) on the final exam.
